

2006 LIST OF AREAS OF TRAINING

The areas of training list is intended to identify candidates who have earned diplomas or degrees in areas with good medium-term job prospects. It is compiled with particular regard to Québec job market requirements.

The diploma or degree must have been obtained in the five years previous to applying for a Québec Selection Certificate (QSC). If this is not the case, the applicant must have worked for at least one year out of the five years in question in a field directly related to the diploma or degree obtained and for which assessment is being made.

This list is authorized by the Minister responsible for the Act respecting immigration to Québec for the purpose of applying the Regulation respecting the selection of foreign nationals (R.R.Q. c. 1-0.2, r.5).

This list came into effect on October 16, 2006.

Since this list is to be brought up to date on a yearly basis in order to take into account medium-term job prospects in Québec's labour market, we wish to bring to your attention that it is the *Areas of training list* in effect **at the time** your file is examined that will apply.
